




BUSINESS CLIMATE INDICATOR FOR THE EURO AREA

Business Climate Indicator decreases in April

In April, the Business Climate Indicator (BCI) for the euro area decreased (by -0.09 points to +1.35). Managers' appraisals of the *past production and overall order books* worsened markedly, as did, to a lesser extent, appraisals of *export order books*. Meanwhile, managers' *production expectations* improved substantially. Only their assessment of the *stocks of finished products* remained virtually unchanged.

Information

The Directorate-General Economic and Financial Affairs (DG ECFIN) of the European Commission publishes the Business Climate Indicator every month.
