



### Large differences in HC and LTC spending




# HC and LTC spending as a fiscal challenge



**Policy Options: A:** Improving the governance of health care systems Policy Options: B:Enhancing the sustainability and efficiency of health care systems



#### A. IMPROVING THE GOVERNANCE OF HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS

through:

- strengthening the cooperation between fiscal and health policy authorities and employing a wide range of budgetary planning tools;
- 2. adjusting the **regulatory framework** to support and strengthen efficiency, transparency and accountability;
- 3. setting up of information technology and data management strategies, to support **monitoring and governance**;
- 4. assessing **health-policy reforms** ex-ante and ex-post in a systematic and formalised manner based on evidence and;
- 5. using **workforce planning** tools to actively manage the health workforce.



## **B. ENHANCING THE SUSTAINABILITY AND EFFICIENCY OF HEALTH CARE FINANCING AND SPENDING**.

This includes:

- 1. improving the **financing mix**;
- 2. benefits packages need to be based on **cost-effectiveness criteria** and **cost-sharing schemes** should support the containment of public spending, while preserving access;
- 3. moving away from **hospital-centric models**;
- 4. strengthening the cost-effective use and the affordability of medicines.



- The Joint Report provides a very detailed account of countryspecific challenges for each Member State and identifies good practices on improving the cost-effectiveness of health and longterm care systems, as well as Policy options based on bestpractice interventions across the EU.
- Taking into consideration [...] Art. 168, the Council [...] INVITES the Commission to factor these findings into [...] the European Semester and explore how Union action can complement national policies, with a clear focus on fiscal sustainability.
- The Council INVITES Member States to factor these findings into the implementation of their national policies where appropriate and relevant in different national contexts.
