Dear Minister,

We write further to the letter of 2 July from Prime Minister Conte and you, informing the Commission of Italy's latest fiscal decisions, notably the mid-year budget and new spending-freezing clause regarding 2019, and reiterating the government's commitment to achieving a structural improvement in line with the requirements of the Stability and Growth Pact in 2020.

The Commission is of the view that this package is material enough to conclude that the opening of an Excessive Deficit Procedure is no longer warranted at this stage. This conclusion is set out in a Communication from the Commission to the Council and in greater detail in an accompanying staff working document which have been published on the Commission website.¹ The Commission will keep under surveillance the effective implementation of this package. It will monitor closely the execution of the 2019 budget and will assess the compliance of the 2020 draft budgetary plan with the Stability and Growth Pact.
