


FLASH CONSUMER CONFIDENCE INDICATOR FOR THE EU AND EURO AREA

In October 2024, DG ECFIN's flash estimate¹ of the consumer confidence indicator² increased further, by 0.5 percentage points (pps.) in the EU and by 0.4 pps. in the euro area. Standing at -11.2 points in the EU, consumer confidence has reached its long-term average for the first time since February 2022. In the euro area, at -12.5, consumer confidence still falls slightly short of its long-term average.

Information

Data collection period: October 1-22.

Release policy of the Consumer Confidence Indicator (CCI): Every month, the Directorate-General Economic and Financial Affairs (DG ECFIN) of the European Commission releases the flash CCI for the EU and euro-area aggregates, using the data available on the cut-off date. The final Consumer Survey results are then published as part of the full Business and Consumer Survey release at the end of the month.

The Joint Harmonised EU Programme of Business and Consumer Surveys is managed by DG ECFIN's Unit Economic situation, forecasts, business and consumer surveys (A3), Sector Business and consumer surveys and short-term forecast.

¹ This month's Flash CCI for the EU aggregate is computed on the basis of consumer survey data from 25 EU countries (all except Ireland and Spain), covering 89,0% (EU) and 87.1% (euro area) of total private final consumption expenditure.

² The consumer confidence indicator builds on replies to selected questions addressed to consumers according to the Joint Harmonised EU Programme of Business and Consumer Surveys.
