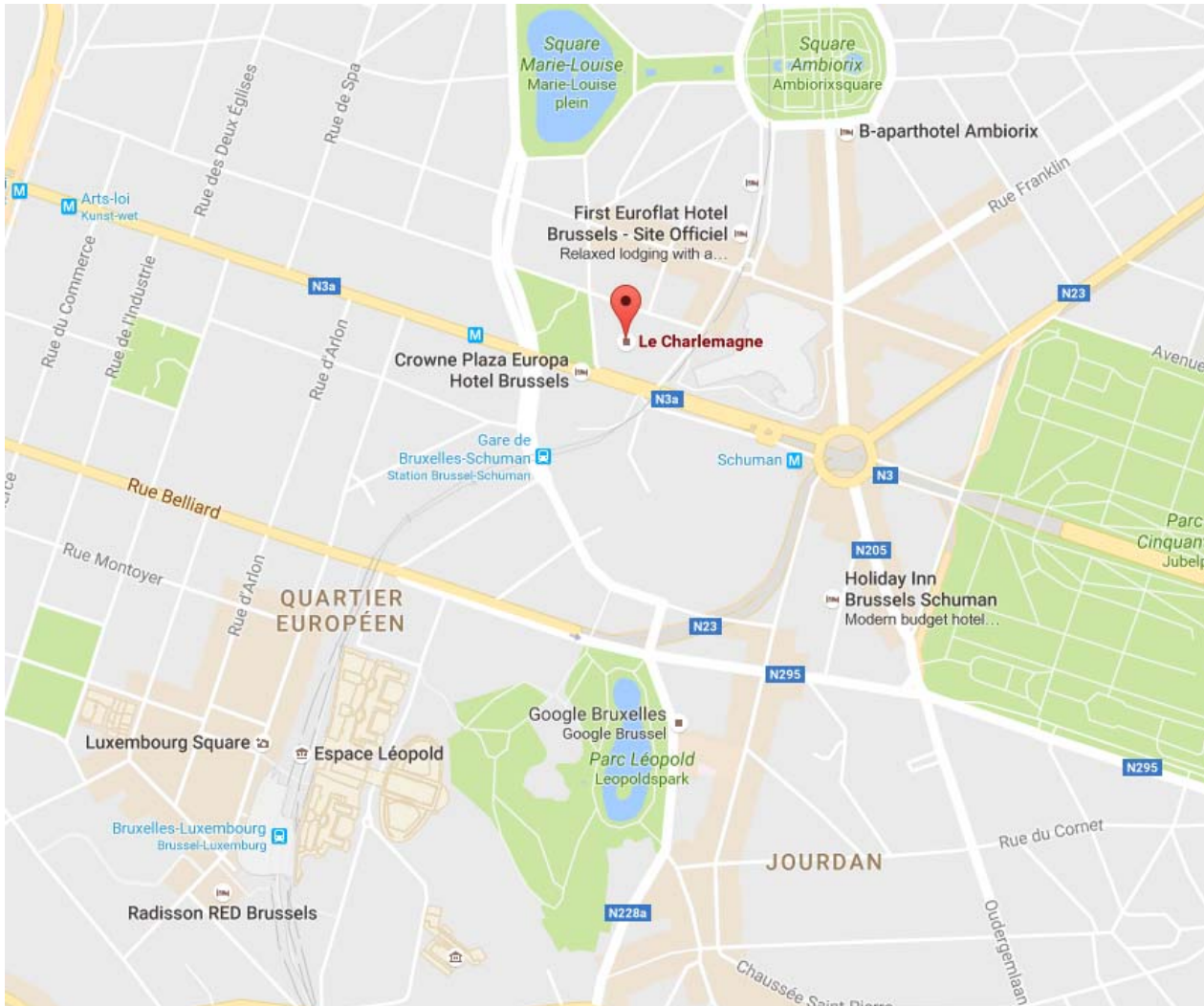

PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

THE CONFERENCE VENUE (CHARLEMAGNE BUILDING) IS LOCATED CLOSE TO THE SCHUMAN ROUNDABOUT (ROND POINT SCHUMAN/SCHUMANPLEIN)

The conference will take place in the European Commission's Charlemagne Building, room Jenkins (JENK).

ADDRESS : Rue de la Loi 170, 1000 Brussels

Please **bring a copy of the e-mail invitation sent to you**, as well as a **passport or identity card** in order to meet the security requirements to gain entry to the Charlemagne building. Once inside the building, please present yourself to the registration desk of the workshop in order to get your badge.

HOW TO GET TO THE CONFERENCE VENUE



1. *From Brussels-National Airport:*

- **Taxi:** Licensed taxis are available outside the Arrivals hall. It will take you about 20 minutes and the fare should cost around €40-€45.
- **Bus:** Airport line. Take the Bus No 12 or 21 from the Bus Station on the level below the Arrivals, to "Schuman" bus stop, a three-minute walk from the workshop venue. The journey should take around 30-45 minutes and cost €6 if the ticket is bought on board (€4 if bought in advance).
- **Train:** Trains run from the airport (Level -1) to Brussels Central Station (Gare Centrale). The journey will take you 20 minutes and will cost around €7.50.

2. *From Brussels Central Station (Gare Centrale):*

- **Metro:** Take Metro Line 1, direction Stockel/Stokkel or Line 5, direction Herrmann-Debroux and get off at "Schuman" station. The journey should take 10 minutes or less and cost around €2,5.

3. *From Brussels Gare du Midi/Zuid:*

- If arriving by train (including Eurostar and Thalys) at Brussels Gare du Midi/Zuid Station, you could take
 - a **taxi** from there (allow at least 15 minutes) or
 - take the **metro**: Line 6, direction Simonis, **change** at Arts-Loi/Kunst-Wet and take the metro
Line 1, direction "Stockel" **or**
Line 5, direction "H.Debroux")
and get off at "Schuman".
